It's so easy. Place the dead bird on one side of the scale, A piece of your own flesh on the other. When the scale balances, You will no longer suffer.

(vrouwenkoor)

Ha ha ha ha, This is easy. The little bird is no bigger Than your little finger. where shall I cut the flesh? Your hand? Your leg? No no no no Ha ha ha ha! That will not hurt. Are you sure? Will you help me? It won't hurt. Ha ha ha... Yes, it won't hurt. Ha ha ha... Let us help you: one, two, three... Ouch! Ouch! The pain is killing me... Ha ha ha! Your flesh is larger than the little bird. Why the scale is not balanced? Oh, no! Did you not say it would be balanced? Come! Let's cut off one more. No way! No way!

Oh Nature, the Compassionate One You are born for all lives Awake for the world Mother of the Earth Light of enlightenment You say all lives shall be equal Heaven and Earth shall be one, Men shall respect all creatures, And all shall live in loving peace. 3. The Deer of Nine Colors

(Sopraan)

(Kantonees, gesproken als in Chinese opera) A long time ago, I was a tree, but then I was cut down innocently... I, after waiting for a thousand years, the benevolent Nature finally let me reincarnate, and reincarnation became a deer! I am the soul of the forest, I belong to the forest, and I emit the nine colors of the forest, so people call me: The Deer of Nine Colors

One day I was with my deer sisters by the lake By the mystic lake that is known by none, where my sisters and I dwell. Through silvery woods we deer roam, into misty fairy, ethereal light **Deer of Nine Colors** Suddenly in distance we heard: Help! Help! Someone is drowning. He's calling for help. I must go rescue him! But, my deer sister said, "Do not go! Do not go! Once you go, we will be exposed. Humans will come to hunt us down. Velvet peeled, antlers torn, Skin stripped to make their gowns. What more? They will eat our flesh! Do not go! He is shouting: Help! I must go to rescue him! 4. Black Air

(koor)

The air is black The wind is dark The water is crying And the Tears of Nature are like rainforest Come and go without a trace Life and death is like ocean and air Now, in black, in dark Nowadays breathe in, breathe out O Nature the life you give to all beings Are threatened by humans Forgive me and my greed Let your thousands of Karmas Caress our sinful souls For no longer to destroy you Oh Nature

5. Fire and Sea

(Mongoolse khoomei-bas met morin khuur)

Flaming sea. Melting rocks. Combined with a never-seen solar eclipse. With exhaustion I reach the dried-up river, Only to find this mysterious woman Taking some of her final breaths... Let me now Pray to the deities With my music To bring her back From the grasp of death

Finally, you are awakening...

(Tibetaanse inheemse sopraan)

In my previous life, I was a deer, but I was hunted and killed by dreamers. The compassionate nature made me reincarnate into a woman in this life... Now, I waked up. My hometown's silkworms died away two years ago I travelled across the Silk Road To collect baby silkworms and pupae. These are the ones I found in Suzhou. I put them right here in my hair. To bring them back home from the opposite end of the Silk Road...

Silk Road, an invisible road. Connecting our tangible hearts.

(Mongoolse khoomei-bas)

In your heart...

(Tibetaanse inheemse sopraan)

My name is Nina. You are...?

(Mongoolse khoomei-bas met morin khuur)

For seventeen years I roamed the west, To collect the Heart Sutra and sacred music And bring them back to my hometown of Dunhuang I am Kongxian, a minstrel monk.

(Tibetaanse inheemse sopraan)

Dunhuang, I have been there. The caves and murals mesmerize me! Beautiful legends, dreams and beliefs.

(beiden)

Dunhuang's murals vividly paint

Home lies so far away, Wandering hearts are heavy and weary. Roaming across a barren land, What day will I return? All those I have encountered are strangers, Until I met a kindred soul in the desert.

(Mongoolse khoomei-bas met morin khuur)

Nina, you are shivering!

(Tibetaanse inheemse sopraan)

It is freezing... Melody sighs over miserable fate. Sorrow makes those tenuous strings break. You came to me like the blossoming spring, Stringing along hopes and dreams, But my life is fading away... We must have met in a previous life. Do not leave me now. It will be difficult to meet again in our next life... *(He sobs.)* I feel your sorrow. You feel my heartbreak. Our love is destined to part.

(Mongoolse khoomei-bas met morin khuur)

Nina, see you next life ...

(koor)

(Heart sutra, vertaald door Meester Xuan Zang (Tang-dynastie) ry va lo ki tesvaro bodhisattvo mwuhaim The Bodhisattva of Compassion, When he meditated deeply, saw the emptiness of all five skandhas And sundered the bonds that caused him suffering.

(Tibetaanse inheemse sopraan en bassen)

Oh, Sariputra, Form does not differ from emptiness, And emptiness does not differ from form. Form is emptiness;

Emptiness is Form;

So are feelings, perceptions, mental formations and consciousness.

Sariputra,

All things and phenomena are in nature Emptiness:

they are non-arising, non-ceasing,

Non-defiled, non-pure,

Non-increasing, non-decreasing.

Therefore, in emptiness there are no forms,

No feelings, perceptions, mental formations or consciousness.

No eyes, ears, nose, tongue, body or mind;

No sights, sounds, smells, tastes, touch or mind object;

No realm of the eyes,

Up to no realm of consciousness.

No ignorance,

And no ending of ignorance,

Up to no old age and death,

And no ending of old age and death.

No Suffering,

No Accumulation or Cessation of Suffering, nor the Path.

No wisdom, and no attainment.

With nothing to attain,

The Bodhisattva

Relying on Prajna Paramita

Has no hindrance in his mind.

Because there is no hindrance,

He has no fear,

And he leaves distorted dream-thinking far behind.

And reaches ultimate Nirvana.

All Buddhas of the past, present and future,
